## **Cherub Choir Parents:**

The Safe Sanctuary Program was created to develop policies and procedures to help ensure the safety of our children, youth, and adults who work with them. As part of that task, the following drop-off and pick-up procedures for the Cherub Choir are as follows.

1. All children will be dropped off at the playground ramp coming from Greenville Street next to Matrix Insurance or escorted to **ROOM 203** by a parent or other designated adult. (Anyone, other than parents, who will be dropping off or picking up your children on a regular basis or in case of an emergency, need to be designated in writing and given to David Kinrade. Further reference to parent(s) includes designated adult(s).)
2. The children will enter the building through the playground door where choir moms will greet them and take them to **ROOM 203**. Choir starts at 4:15. After 4:25, you will need to escort your child to the choir room.
3. Children leaving the church after choir will be picked up at the **ROOM 203** door by a parent or will be taken to drop off point outside the playground door.
5. Choir ends at 5:00. Children not picked up by 5:10 will be taken to the nursery in **Room 213**. Parents will have to go to the nursery to pick up their children after 5:10.

Please, understand that these procedures are being adopted for the safety of our children. Although they are very responsible in most situations, they are less likely to be as cautious on church grounds and perhaps not as focused on their surroundings. The streets and parking lots surrounding the church are very busy that time of day. People come to the doors of our church nearly every day seeking financial or other assistance. These are people we know nothing about. The above procedures will help us better protect our children where they already feel protected.
